In the Church

on vacation May 22 – 28 and away Memorial Day holiday. The Study Leave is May 30th through August 29th. One week will be the Worship Planning week included in my terms of call. The final week of my time away will be vacation and the Labor Day holiday. I will be back in the church office on Tuesday, September 5th.

Throughout the 12 weeks of Study Leave, I will visit over a dozen congregations in seven states. I'll also explore local and national church archives. In mid-June, I will have the opportunity to attend an *Iftar*, which is the meal at the end of each day of Ramadan. The *Iftar* will he hosted by the Islamic Center of Minnesota, which in collaboration with the Minnesota Council of Churches, is inviting non-Muslims to participate in the meal and conversation. I will also participate in a Writer's Workshop at Princeton Seminary, and I'll do worship planning at the Benedictine Center in Schuyler.

Throughout the Study Leave, I will take time for spiritual disciplines that I let languish in the busyness of church life. I read a poem recently that is very timely for this season that Federated and I are about to begin. The poem is titled <u>Praying</u>, by Mary Oliver:

It doesn't have to be the blue iris, it could be weeds in a vacant lot, or a few small stones; just pay attention, then patch
