Associate Pastor's Report

Every year when May 5th comes around, my wife and I ask our kids what is special about this day. Often they'll begin by saying it's Cinco de Mayo, a Mexican American day of celebration. Then they will say it is Children's Day, which is observed as a holiday on May 5th in South Korea.

Growing up in a Korean family, I learned early on that this was a special day. It felt like a big deal that my brother and I would be excused from school that day to go on our own special field trip. A couple times, our dad would take us to the zoo or an amusement park - while mom took care of the family business. There would a few times when an unfamiliar Korean adult would take us on a special day trip - while both our parents stayed at work.

As an adult I've learned that Children's Day in South Korea is a major event with jampacked venues (such as parks, museums and zoo) and highways that resemble filled parking lots. Observance of Children's Day was founded in 1923 by Jung-Hwan Bang, a children's book author. The special day was meant to draw attention to the needs of children - especially during a tumultuous time in Korean history.


