- One: As you keep God's commands, you live deeply and surely in God, and God lives in you. And this is how you experience God's deep and abiding presence: by the Spirit God gave you.
- All: "Peace I leave with you; my peace I give to you. I do not give to you as the world gives. Do not let your hearts be troubled, and do not let them be afraid." (John 14:27)
- Mentors: Like grain baked into one loaf,
