

Pickle Ball nets are up in the gym and can be enjoyed by small groups.



Many of you have seen the envelopes pictured above. They are scattered throughout the Church during this season. These handy little envelopes help us decipher how you want your money distributed each time you contribute!

By using the Christmas Joy envelope, you donate your funds to the UCC and PC(USA) Christmas funds, 50 - 50. Noted below are other ways to donate towards these funds. These funds are explained below:

PC(USA) Christmas Joy Special Offerings (right): This special offering provides assistance to current and retired church workers and their families in their time of need, and develops our future leaders at Presbyterian-related schools and colleges equipping communities of color.

<u>UCC The Christmas Fund (below)</u>: Your gifts to the Christmas Fund allow the United Church Board for Ministerial Assistance to provide grace, hope and joy through financial relief to UCC pastors, lay church leaders, and their families, including pension supplements, health benefits, emergency grants and more.



- Monthly pension supplementation for 218 retired clergy and lay employees (\$1,042,726)
- Health benefits supplementation for 86 retired clergy and lay employees (\$181,389)
- Emergency grants for 55 individuals and families (\$138,022)
- Christmas "Thank You" gift checks to 479 retired clergy and lay employees (\$278,500)
