A dishonest steward found out he'd been fired;

he thought, "I'm in trouble! Now what will I do?

It's not very likely that I'll soon be hired, so I'll make a plan to get out of this stew."

He called up the people who owed his boss money;

he settled their debts at deep discount that day.

Those debtors were thrilled that their day had turned sunny; now they were indebted to him, in a way.

His boss heard what happened but did not reverse it;

His debtors were praising him; what could he do?

That boss seemed the hero; he'd make matters worse if
