From the Pastor's Desk

May has felt like a very full month. Maybe it's because there were five Sundays this May. Speaking of a fifth Sunday, the Membership & Growth Committee is preparing to host a 5th Sunday Potluck on August 29th – please mark that on your calendar. A potluck was not feasible for May because of the holiday weekend with the 5th Sunday.

Looking ahead to June, we have several important events happening in the life of our church. On June 13th, we will have a baptism for Sylas Micek (son of Dylan & Miranda Micek and grandson of Randy & Anita Kaspar). Baptisms, particularly for infants, always remind me of God making the first move in loving us – even before we can understand who God is or able to show our love to God. This baptism is extra special because Miranda and Dylan made their request to join Federated Church as members while requesting the baptism for Sylas. All requests were approved by Governing Council in April.

Also on June 13th, there will be a special congregational meeting after worship to vote on the staffing plan that was recommended by the Pastor Staff Plan Task Force last December. The congregation did not get to vote on this at the February Annual Meeting because more details were needed for when the staffing plan change would go into effect. The motion that will be voted on is included in this newsletter (page 5). Absentee ballots are available on the church website, office and by request. Completed ballots will need to be returned by Friday, June 11th, 4:00pm local time to be included for the congregational vote.

The motion is fairly straightforward in terms of Federated Church moving from a two-pastor church (with senior and associate pastors) to a one-pastor church (with a solo pastor). Approval of this is needed for the Pastor Nominating Committee (PNC) to proceed in their search for a solo pastor – as opposed to a senior pastor who might expect an associate pastor.

Details on the timing of staffing plan are included because there needs to be an approval by the Homestead Presbytery – alongside approval by our congregation. On the official start date of the solo pastor (who is nominated by the PNC and called by the congregation), the staffing change will go into effect. On the day before, the position of installed associate pastor will be eliminated. For those who are concerned about Federated Church no longer being a two-pastor church, it should be stated that the church could go back to having two pastors. The only restriction is that "a position may not be reopened or revalidated for a period of two years after the position was eliminated" (according to the Homestead Presbytery Commission On Ministry Manual; I am not aware of any restrictions by the United Church of Christ).

There is another important date in June: Father's Day (6/20). It will be refreshing to have this holiday in a relatively quiet month.

They have a number of animals available, including Duckey, Little Foot and Chase.








