#### From the Pastor's Desk

Lent is a time of reflection on our mortality. We begin on Ash Wednesday with a visible reminder of how "you are dust, and to dust you shall return." This year's Lent included a further prompt for considering death. On Tuesday morning (March 12<sup>th</sup>) I realized it was the 14<sup>th</sup> anniversary of my father's passing.

It is hard to believe it is been that many years; I can still remember the events of that day. I was driving on Highway 101 (with traffic, of course). My brother called and informed me that our dad died. By the time I got to my parents' home, my father was already transported to a nearby hospital. I waited in the hospital waiting room for several hours. The education pastor I worked with accompanied me for some of that time (side note: Sunnie and Ethan were in South Korea during this time), and he shared from his experience of his father passing away. Then, the doctor came out and said there was nothing more they could do. It hit me then that life would not be the same. I was entering an unfamiliar territory: life without a father.

The official cause of death was heart failure. Yet, I know that was not the real reason why my father died. His heart gave out after a yearlong battle with cancer, specifically multiple myeloma. A year prior, my mom and dad visited Sunnie and me in Vancouver, Canada to see their grandchild. When they got back to Los Angeles, my dad injured his back pulling out luggage from the car trunk. The pain from that injury did not go away. Eventually, he went to see a doctor about the pain and learned that he had an incurable cancer. We were glad that he could receive medical treatment through the Veterans Administration hospital system.

#### From the Pastor's Desk (cont.)

My brother escorted him to the numerous appointments for treatment and follow-up. When I moved to back to California in the fall of 2004, I was able to help out with driving and waiting in hospitals.

For a while, we thought the treatments were working. There were days when my dad was feeling well and other days that were not so good. Nonetheless, his health continued to decline. My father, who was an avid bicycler and roller-skater, had difficulty during the last months with even walking indoor. A special hospital bed was put in the living room so that he would not have to walk much.

There are a lot of emotions for me with March 12<sup>th</sup>. I feel sadness that I was not at my father's bedside when he took his last breath. There is anger and sorrow that he is no longer around. And within the mixed bag of emotions, there is peace that my dad is with our Creator and no longer suffering. My mom recalls how my dad was surprisingly eating so well that last day (cancer medicine had ruined his appetite). She briefly thought his health was improving. Looking back, she thinks that my dad was enjoying his final meal and that gives her peace with his departure.

During this season of Lent, I would invite you to think about your experience(s) with the death of loved ones. Where are you in the grieving process (for example, Elizabeth Kubler Ross describes five stages of grief: denial, anger, bargaining, depression, and acceptance)? What has been helpful in mourning the loss? I would be honored to hear your stories, whether it be written form or in conversation.


#### Platte Valley Humane Society
